

## Fact sheet about Sigrid Rudebeck's High School

### General information

The school was founded in 1869 by the reform educator Sigrid Rudebeck and has been teaching at upper secondary level since 1904 in premises on Bellmansgatan in central Gothenburg.

Sigrid Rudebeck's high school run in the form of a non-profit limited company and is wholly owned by the Sigrid Rudebeck Foundation.

- The school offers two university preparatory programs (NA / SA) and has about 470 students.

### Premises

In addition to the 16 home classrooms, there are general teaching rooms, fully equipped laboratory rooms, music- and picture rooms, computer rooms, study rooms and living rooms, as well as two larger auditoriums. Library available.

Physical education takes place in Landala sports halls.

### Teaching

Teaching is conducted by 29 certified teachers, one of whom is a trained special educator and one is a trained special teacher in mathematics.

The school offers teacher-led teaching and lessons are scheduled Mon-Fri.

Traditional teaching elements are deliberately portioned out with modern working methods and tools.

Textbooks, digital resources and equipment in practical subjects are available. School work does not require your own computer, but the school provides laptops when needed and the school's various computer rooms are available every school day from 07.30 to 17.00.

The school has "Schoolity" as a learning platform. Schoolity is a complete learning platform with integrated scheduling. It is simple and user-friendly and is also available to download in their mobile phone.

### Student health

The school counselor and school nurse are full-time employees and are at the school every day.

The school doctor's office is coordinated by the school nurse and the school psychologist is available when needed.

### School counselor (SYV)

Study and career guidance are offered on the school premises every week by trained study and career counselors.

### School lunch

Lunch is served at the school and the food is prepared on site by our own school lunch staff (Bamba).
